Energy community obligation:

Goals

Serbia has to increse share of electricity generated from renewable energy sources

20% → **27%**



Strategy

Subsidizing private companies to invest in renewable energy –
privileged producers sell energy at higher price for the period of 12 years

Electricity bills are therefore increased by a separate fee

Most popular —— Small hydro power plants

Early stage - Problems with the implementation
(Investors complained about bureaucracy - many of them <u>gave up</u>)

- Remarkable evidence of environmental devastation
- Violation of environmental law
- Insitututions put a blind eye on the problem
- Blame-shifting
- Pressure



"...workers were using bulldozers, machines similar to dredgers, to pull out and cut down vegetation by the river, thus practically aggravating its recovery, and indirectly jeopardizing riverbank stability.... We believe that all the activities undertaken and the condition of nature in the observed part of the water course indicate to arbitrary decisions of individual investors, serious jeopardizing the river bed, alluvial plains, and the hydrological regime."
