### What I learned about coordination

- 1. Select the right team. Small is beautiful.
- 2. Find suitable funding and use it to organise your time: psychology of limitations
- 3. Set aside funding for a coordinator
- 4. Write an MOU, discuss it and get everyone to sign
- 5. Create a platform and then use it
- 6. Meet regularly and communicate constantly
- 7. Split into smaller teams when necessary
- 8. Be religious about organisation
- 9. Meet up if you can
- 10. Set deadlines and stick to them

## How it all started

- Cross-border & collaborative journalism
   programme by German Toepfer Foundation;
- Raw topic with cross-border potential;
- Onboarding Dutch colleagues and VPRO;
- 50K grant from the IJ4EU fund.
- Working time: Sept 2020-Dec 2020.



### What did we find out?

- Tree felling in Estonia's protected areas is increasing;
- More than half of the raw material for pellets comes from roundwood;
- Burning woody biomass for energy is heavily subsidised by Western European countries;
- Estonia's land sector is expected to switch from storing to emitting carbon by 2030;
- The certifications system of the sector is vague.

In a UK setting the government has ben reliant on the Renewable Energy Directive which has guided UK policy. The UK can go stricter and it has done on biomass, because the UK went heavily in for biomass so it's tightened up. The UK government has realised its mistake. It has announced this year that it will end all subsidies for biomass under contracts for difference, which makes there will be no more subsidies for biomass after 2027, we think that's took long. We thought the government should reallocate subsidies under renewable allocation subsidies. That's our major call. We have ha some conversations where the former minister asked for solutions, Clare Perry.

Our fear is that although the government will end subsides for Biomass, if it continues subsidies for BECCS for wood pellets, you're effectively subsidising wood pellets again.
