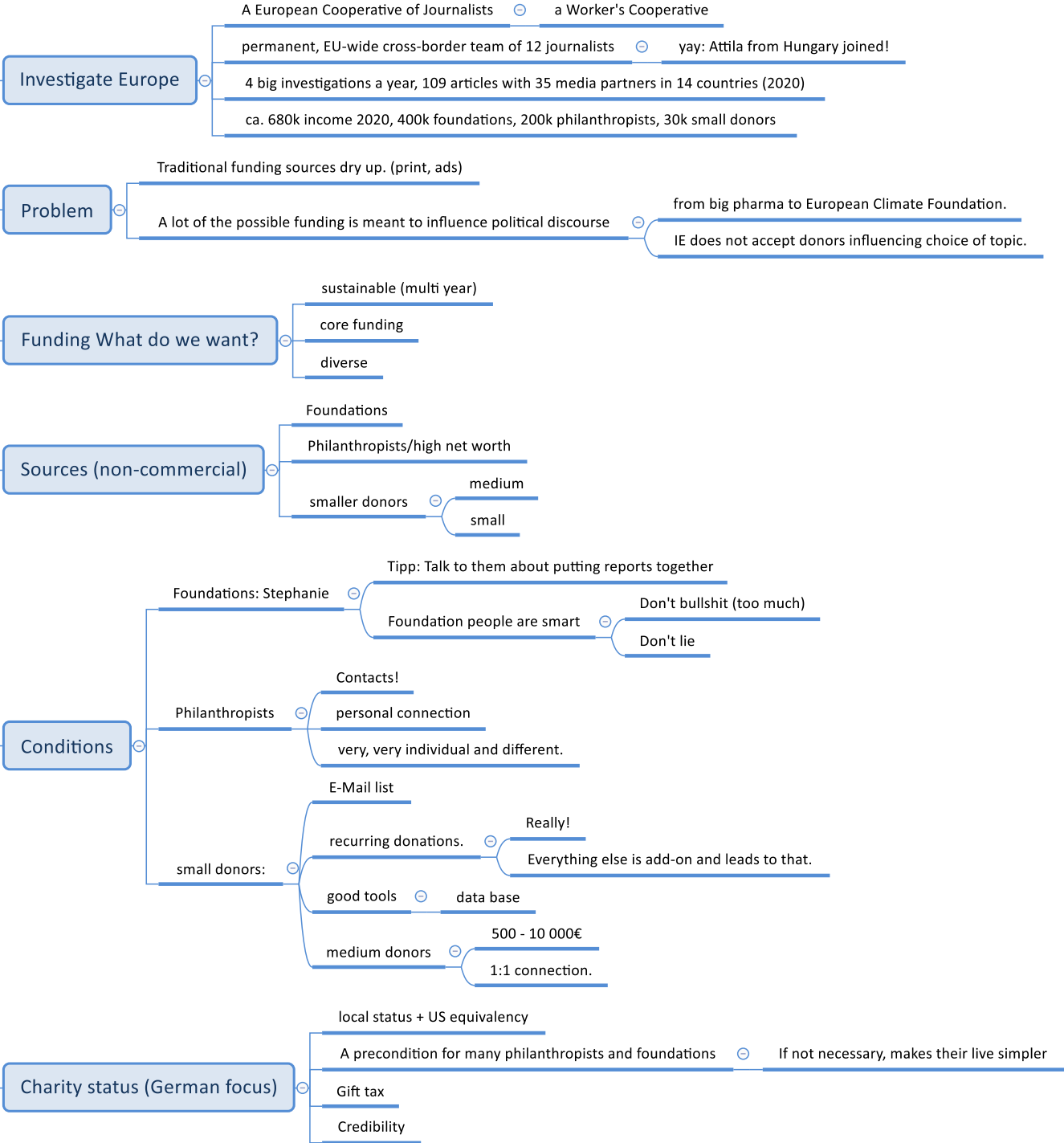

A European Cooperative of Journalists a Worker's Cooperative

permanent, EU-wide cross-border team of 12 journalists yay: Attila from Hungary joined!

4 big investigations a year, 109 articles with 35 media partners in 14 countries (2020)

ca. 680k income 2020, 400k foundations, 200k philanthropists, 30k small donors

Problem

Traditional funding sources dry up. (print, ads)

A lot of the possible funding is meant to influence political discourse

from big pharma to European Climate Foundation.

IE does not accept donors influencing choice of topic.
